Rules and Entry Form

Show Date: Saturday, October 5, 2024 at 10:00 AM

**Show location: Orangeburg County Fairgrounds, Cattle Barn
350 Magnolia St., Orangeburg, SC 29115**

Show Rules and Guidelines:

1. **NO ENTRY FEE.** On show day, the name of each participant will be on a list at the Livestock Gate next to the swine barn. The participant may be accompanied by one adult. Additional passes may be purchased in advance or at the gate.
2. Show is open to all SC 4-H and FFA exhibitors ages 5-18 years old as of January 1, 2024.
3. All goats must be at the barn/arena by 9:00 AM on the day of the show.
4. All goats must be weighed to be eligible to show. Scales will close promptly at 9:45 AM.
5. Judging begins at 10:00 AM.
6. **Open Wethers (3 classes):** Only 4-H/FFA participants will be allowed to participate in Open Wether Classes.
7. **SC Born Wethers (3 classes):** All SC Born Wethers must be tagged with a SC scrapies tag.
8. **Market Does (3 classes):** Market does must be born between September 1, 2023, and June 15, 2024. Only one doe per exhibitor per class will be allowed. Each exhibitor may weigh in up to 3 does. Exhibitors with more than one doe in a class, will be required to choose which doe he/she wants to show in that class.
9. **Showmanship:** Showmanship is open to SC 4-H/FFA youth. Exhibitors can show any goat in Showmanship that they have entered in any other class. See exhibitor age classes below.

10. The youth must be able to maintain control their animal(s) at all times during this event. Parents are not allowed in the Show Ring during judging. Parents entering the ring during judging will result in the exhibitor being disqualified.
11. Cloverbud exhibitors may request a Senior exhibitor to accompany them in Market Wethers or Market Doe classes only. NO assistants will be allowed in Showmanship. The assistant is only allowed to step in and control the goat for the safety of the exhibitor(s) or the goat.
12. The Orangeburg Fair reserves the right to make decisions concerning or changing rules, regulations, and/or health requirements. Any animal exhibiting any significant visible symptoms of disease or sickness will not be allowed to be unloaded from the vehicle or remain on the fair grounds.
13. Exhibitors must furnish water for their animal(s).
14. Premiums will be paid according to the schedule on this Rules and Entry Form.
15. All decisions by the judge are final.

All participants will register their wether goat in the market class 300. Market classes will be divided into the following classes after all goats have been weighed in. (Class 301, Class 302, 303, and Class 304)

Market Doe: Only one doe per exhibitor per class is allowed. Limit 3 does weighed in.

Does will be divided into the following classes after all goats have been weighed in. (Class 401, Class 402, & Class 404)

Scoring:

1. Record Book Interview: 25%
The record book should be as complete as possible but will not need to be finalized. [Senior Dairy Record Book](#)
The record book will be returned following scoring.
2. Knowledge College: 50%
Year 1: Written Exam in the project area.
Year 2: Written Exam and Sales Talk
3. Showmanship: 25%

PRESIDENT'S CHOICE AWARD

Cloverbud Beef – Belt Buckle

Junior/Senior – Belt Buckle

Purpose: The President's Award is designed to bestow the highest recognition to an outstanding exhibitor of the Orangeburg County Fair who has demonstrated exceptional involvement in the livestock industry, advocate for agriculture and recognized as a recipient of the highest honor of the Orangeburg County Fair.

Selection: One President Award Recipient will be selected from Cloverbuds and one President Award Recipient will be selected from Juniors/Seniors out of all the specie shows combined.

Guidelines:

- The Orangeburg County Fair President's Competition is open to all 2024 Orangeburg County Fair youth exhibitors.
- Once a youth exhibitor is recognized with the President's Award, they will not be eligible to compete for this award in the same age division again.

Selection Information: This distinguished award will be selected by the President of the Orangeburg County Fair and livestock shows support staff.

The intent of this prestigious award is determined on the following criteria:

- Exhibits will be evaluated by the Fair President and the Orangeburg County Fair Show Staff.
- Cleanliness of the exhibit area from the species check in through the show.
- Identification such as stall cards, farm signs are highly encouraged.
- Manure must be removed from stalls/pens and placed in appropriate containers/areas.
- The appearance of animals should be clean and always cared for.
- Courtesy to other exhibitors, spectators and show officials will count towards the award. Disregard for show and facility rules and regulations will count against award calculations.
- Positive interaction with the public during the competition time frame.
